

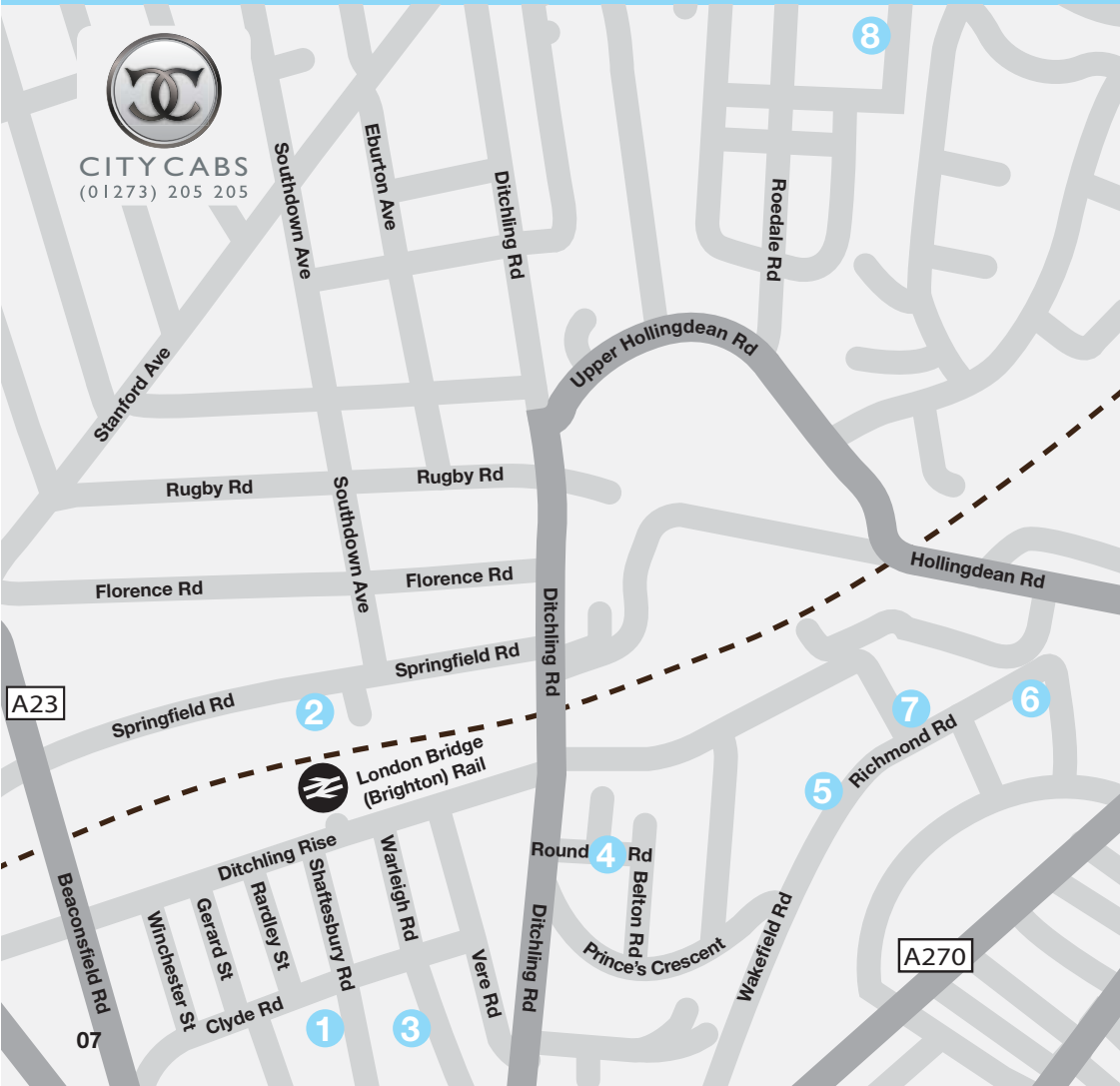

Tucked away in a recent development, this modern plantsman's garden, now in its sixth year, surrounds an end-of-terrace house, packing a lot of interest into an L-shaped plot. Planted for texture and colour, the garden includes 15-metre mixed border, hot border, kitchen garden, greenhouse, courtyard garden, specimen plants and lots of pots, dahlias, bananas, grasses, sweet peas and clematis.

This is a small walled town garden with an awkward aspect-hard flinty chalky soil which would suggest most plants are container grown. However, small trees and herbaceous plants thrive. The garden spans out to a large expanse behind providing a haven for wildlife.

Welcome to a small, south-facing garden on a sloping, triangular plot. Originally an area to dry washing for the local laundry, it is now laid out quite formally with box and beech hedging to create separate areas of interest.
