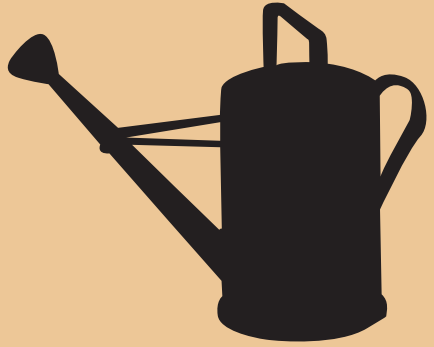

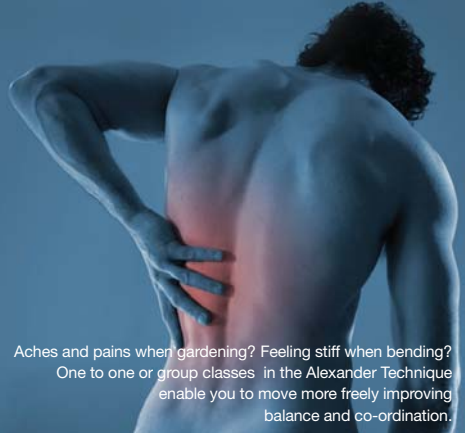

Ed Iken

- Head gardener at Nymans Gardens

Has an organic tip for battling the black spot on your roses- apply one part milk/ten parts water, a teaspoon of sunflower oil and a little Ecover washing up liquid.

suggests that if your pear tree is failing to fruit - Make sure there is another pear tree nearby to pollinate it – and keep it well fed and watered.
